

# **Brodsworth Treasure Hunt 2015**

*A mystery ride, that you're on today.  
No arrows to see, 'cos clues guide the way.  
Answers to find, all within sight,  
Have fun trying. To ride and write!*

1. Out of the car park, before you turn right.

In front stands, an informative sight.

Before you set off, upon the road,

Note down item 1, of the Forest Code.

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2. On the left is a post, that comes into view.

What two colours, are above blue?

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3. You'll go straight ahead, at the crossroads you've met.

But before you go, there's an answer to get.

A post on the left, names a different way.

Write down the name, that the words do say.

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4. Soon you will meet, lots of paths.

Go straight ahead, a track of grass.

And at this junction, if you're good

Name the two critters, carved in wood.

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5. This grassy track, is nice for a canter.

Then its left down the hill, as you chat and banter.

As you cross the bridge, and start heading right.

What colour post, first comes into sight?

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***CARRY ON STRAIGHT AHEAD AT THE TOP OF THE SHORT HILL.***

6. Hope your equine girls and boys,

Do not mind the traffic noise.

The motorway sign is just in view

What two towns are written on blue?

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7. A board you'll pass, along your way.

Tells you of, a bird of prey.

Lots of info, this notice gives.

How long does it say, a kestrel lives?

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8. Towering up above the trees.  
How many windmills can you see? \_\_\_\_\_

**CONTINUE AHEAD, PAST THE SMALL CAR PARK AND FOLLOW THE  
MAIN TRACK UP THE HILL WITHOUT TURNING OFF.**

9. At the top of the hill, before you turn right.  
A loan toadstool, comes into sight.  
Before you have, a merry trot.  
Count the dents, in its top. \_\_\_\_\_

*No clues for a while, so nothing to read.  
This stretch is ideal, to travel at speed.  
(approx. 300 yards)*

**HEAD RIGHT - (DO NOT GO OVER THE STONE BRIDGE)**

*At the first junction, that comes into sight,  
Slow down a little, and take your first right!*

**FOLLOW THE TRACK DOWN THE HILL AND ROUND THE BENDS.**

10. The yellow trail, now meets the blue.  
Head right downhill, and into view,  
Wooden things, one, two, three.  
But what are they? I'm asking thee! \_\_\_\_\_

**CROSS THE BRIDGE OVER THE WATER AND TURN LEFT AND CONTINUE  
STRAIGHT AHEAD ON THIS TRACK - ALL THE WAY TO THE END.**

*This stretch has no clues, I've nothing to ask.  
You may go at speed, as there is no task.*

**TURN LEFT AT THE END OF THE TRACK.**

*Pass the picnic bench, that stands alone.  
Then left down the hill, to the bridge of stone!*

**TURN LEFT AFTER CROSSING THE BRIDGE THEN FIRST RIGHT AND  
IMMEADIATELY GO STRAIGHT OVER THE CROSSROADS  
(taking the left hand track up the hill)**

11. Soon you will meet, some metal spheres.  
How many paw prints, do we see here? \_\_\_\_\_

**CONTINUE TO THE TOP OF THE HILL AND HEAD RIGHT  
AT THE JUNCTION.**

12. Stop at the compass, if you aren't racing.  
Tell me which way, the arrow is facing \_\_\_\_\_

**GO STRAIGHT AHEAD – DO NOT TURN RIGHT**

13. Left at the end, but before you go,  
In front you will see, a totem pole.  
Where a bird is carved, and mining tools too,  
What other animal, can you view. \_\_\_\_\_

**STAY ON THE TRACK AND HEAD RIGHT TOWARDS THE CHURCH STEEPLE.**

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**TURN LEFT TOWARDS THE WINDMILLS.**

14. Two wooden leaves, come into view.  
What are these here, for you to do? \_\_\_\_\_

15. Over the bridge with stone walls,  
Turn left, then what can you spy?  
Hiding there amongst the reeds,  
Name this type of fly! \_\_\_\_\_

*All of the answers, I hope you have found.  
Now you are free, to cover some ground.  
Directions now take you, to where you had started,  
If horse is fit, and you aren't faint-hearted.  
Then re-ride the route, its 5 miles per lap.  
Then tell us your mileage, when you get back!*

**STAY ON THE TRACK – DO NOT TURN LEFT**

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**STRAIGHT AHEAD – DO NOT TURN RIGHT OVER THE STONE BRIDGE**

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**THEN TAKE THE NEXT RIGHT OVER THE WOODEN/METAL BRIDGE**

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**UP THE HILL KEEPING LEFT AND FOLLOW THE PROPER PATH BACK TO  
CAR PARK.**

*Clock in your 5 mile circuit, then using this sheet for directions,  
repeat the route as necessary until you have completed  
your desired mileage!*
