



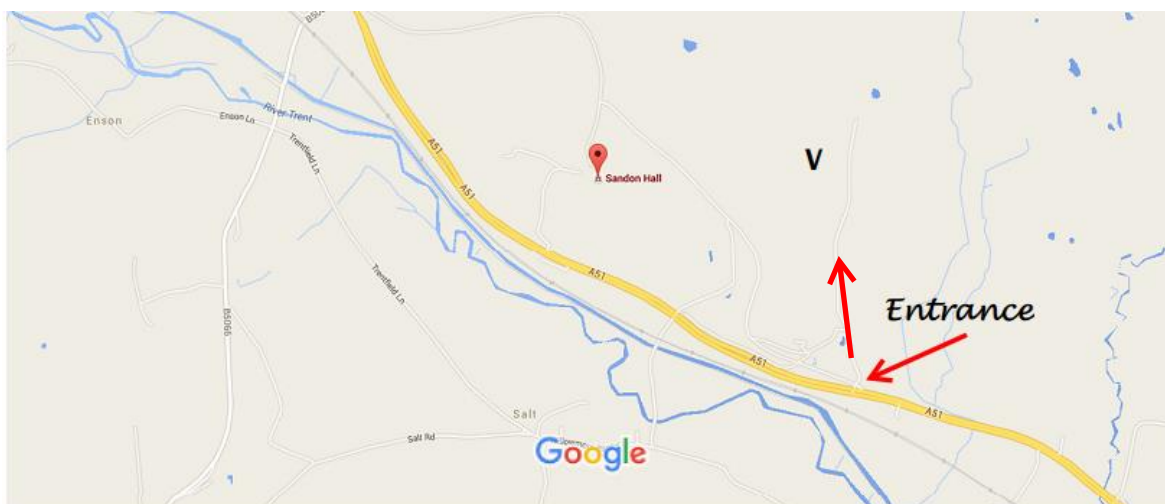
## Sandon Hall Estate Ride – 7 August 2016

**VENUE:** Sandon Estate, off A51 Sandon, Stafford

**DIRECTIONS:** The venue is approached from the A51 at the end of the dual carriageway, between Sandon and Weston (Stone / Rugeley Road)



**Please do not enter the estate from any other entrance. The correct entrance (shown above) will be signposted with Sport Endurance directional signs.**

**Venue Arrival:**

**\*No entries on the day\***

**Riders can arrive at the Venue from 8.00 am. First Vetting 8.45am.**

**First Pleasure Rider out on course 10.00am and last Horse away 12.00 am.**

(Can those doing 20 miles please aim to be out by 11.00)

Please ensure you know your bib number. At the end of the ride members can record their official mileage on the list provided at the secretary.

**Route** - Please note at the request of the Sandon Estate Route Maps will not be published on the website. Competitive Riders may collect a route map from the Secretary on arrival. We ask that these are returned along with your bib.

Official mileage – 10 mile route that can be ridden twice.

**Facilities** – catering van. Toilets. Please note there is no water available.

**First Aider** - This event does not have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the secretary.

**Notes:** Please leave the venue free of all litter and droppings. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. There are gates on the route. Some will be left open but please ensure any gates that you find closed are shut after you - where possible these will be manned.

**Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.**

## **TAIL RIBBONS**

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

**RED RIBBON – My horse may kick**

**GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care**

**BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion**
