

Tre Mostyn Ride

Sunday 17th May 2015



Venue: Wern Home Farm, Plas Uchaf Lane, Tre Mostyn.

Whitford, Holywell, Flinshire. CH8 9AR

Directions to Venue:

From A55 exit at Junction 31 and take A5151 to Prestatyn, go straight over roundabout sign posted Whitford, but do not take immediate right turn on this road to Whitford. After 0.8mile at T junction turn right, take second right signed Tre Mostyn, bear left at junction with tree in middle of road, go through village of Tre Mostyn, turning left to follow signs for farm ride - entrance on right. Keep following signs for farm ride parking, turning left in farm yard

Camping: A warm Welsh welcome will await you. Friday is a busy day on the M6 so you can arrive anytime from 9am Friday and make the most of your stay. Likewise if you are travelling on Saturday you are welcome anytime.

Corralling: Your corral must be doubled stranded and be powered by electric, a sign should be displayed warning the public of the electric fence. All horses should be used to corralling. A sign should hang on your fence displaying your details in case of an emergency.

Camping Supervisor: The ride organiser is not camping so the camp supervisor is Andrea Monk. If you experience any problems whilst camping please contact Andrea who will be on site from Friday.

Vetting – Competitors vetting times will commence from 8.45am. Competitors who are not camping can arrive at the venue from 8am

Pleasure Riders Sunday: You can arrive at the venue from 9.30am. Horses permitted on course between 10am & 11.30am. Please print off your map. The course will be marked in ribbons and spray paint on the ground. Mileage options will be displayed on the day.

On Site: There will be a Catering Van for you to purchase drinks, hot and cold food. As well as a vending machine. Toilets, water are all on site including a wash down area. There is no need to bring your own water.

First Aider: This event does not have an official first aider but there will be a first aid kit situated at the ride secretary.

Jumping: Anyone wishing to jump any of the optional fences must sign the Mostyn ride disclaimer and have their own insurance cover (proof required). Jumping is at your own risk as Sport Endurance does not insure its riders for jumping.

Rules: This ride is run under Sport Endurance rules which a copy can be found on our website <u>www.sportendurance.co.uk</u> No SPURS or whips longer than 30" are permitted.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion

REMEMBER YOUR BIB NUMBER FOR THE SECETARY

All droppings must be picked up off the venue and taken home with you
