



Barton in Fabis Ride

NEW Venue: Barton Equestrian Centre, Barton in Fabis, Notts. NG11 0AA

Venue: The venue is an equestrian centre with field parking. There are toilets, water and a café on site.

Competitors can arrive at the venue from 7am, Pleasure riders can arrive from 10am. Once you have parked up and unloaded your horses please come and check in at the secretary, where you will be issued with your rider bib

**THE VENUE IS A COMPULSORY WALK ZONE.
DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES**

Competitors Briefing – This will take place at the secretary's tent.

Competitors – Your vet times have been allocated on a separate document. Please note you risk elimination if you are late for the vetting. Please make sure you notify the vet writer upon arrival at the vetting. The time you have been given is your time. You **WILL NOT** be able to vet earlier than your time so please do not push in or hang around the vetting area.

The vetting will take approximately 3 minutes as your heart rate will be taken for a full minute. The vet on duty is Caroline Bramhall.

Check the board upon arrival for last minute route changes and confirmed distances as times & points will be worked out from the official mileages displayed on the day. Please ensure you have read the rules

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be properly secured by a chin strap

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Pleasure Riders. You can arrive at the venue from 10am, Pleasure ride times are first horse away 10.30am Last horse 12.30pm

Please be aware that no pleasure riders will be allowed out on course until 10.30am this is to allow the competitors to get underway.

3M – Lead rein route only (talk round/map given on day)

8m route – This is the top part of the loop on the map which takes in lanes, woods & water. (water optional). Plenty of canter opportunities which includes some optional fences around a field, (jumping at own risk) Road crossing are manned and gates tied back.

12m – This is the bottom half of the map which takes in lanes, fields and some wonderful hills. This part of the route requires you to ride through a field of sheep with two bulls, there are horses friendly gates at either end which we hope to have manned depending on helpers.

22 Mile – This is the full course see notes above.

The route will be mark by painted arrows on the floor, tape in trees and arrows. All Marshalls and helpers have given up there day to ensure you have a pleasurable ride, please thank them when passing through.

Red Bibs = Competitor Rider

Yellow Bibs = Pleasure Rider

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion

REMEMBER YOUR BIB NUMBER FOR THE SECETARY

Please print off your map, Vet sheets if required

All droppings must be picked up off the venue and placed in digger bucket on venue
