



Lubcloud Farm Ride

Venue: Lubcloud Farm, Charley Road, Oaks in Charnwood,

LE12 9YA

THE VENUE IS A COMPULSORY WALK ZONE

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times

Venue: You may arrive at the venue from 9.30am. First horse on course 10am last horse away 12midday.

Route options: 6 miles (Incl LR)

12miles

On Site: Catering is provided by Lubcloud Farm Tea Room and will be set up in the venue field: pulled pork barbeque, other filled rolls, scones with jam and cream, tea, coffee & soft drinks.

Toilet available for use in the Tea Room.

No water available so please bring water for your horses.

First Aider

This event does not have an official first aider but there is a first aid kit at the secretary tent.

NOTES:

- Wide gateways allow easy access but some gateways are a little rocky so care should be taken as you go through. Any rocks found on the route have been removed or will be marked. However, these are very few and the going is mostly clear grass fields.

- Please keep to the edge of fields as marked on the map and by the arrows. This is particularly important in the 3 fields planted with crop on Saint Bernard's Abbey land.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" are allowed.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be properly secured by a chin strap

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion

Please print off your map.

All droppings at the venue must be picked up and taken home with you.
