

Prestwold Hall Estate Saturday and Sunday 27th / 28th June 2015

Thank you for entering the ride, here are a few details you need to know before the ride:

Address: Prestwold Hall, Prestwold Lane, Prestwold, nr **Loughborough**, Leics **LE12 5SQ**.

Camping Friday – arrive at venue from 3pm onwards

Riding Saturday + Sunday – **Competitors** arrive at venue from 7.30am (first vetting 9.00am)

Pleasure riders arrive at **venue from 9am** onwards (**set off between 10.00 -1.00**)

Camping Saturday – arrive any time from 9am onwards

Information on the area of the ride:

The venue and route is by kind permission of Edward Packe-Drury-Lowe, Prestwold Hall Estate. The route is across the private estate, on the permissive bridle routes surrounding Prestwold, Hoton and Cotes. Terrain is mostly gently rolling to flat, wide grassy field edges with very little road work. Any gates should be open.

Directions:

From the North and South – M1 to Junction 24 – then take the A6 Derby Road (signposted Kegworth / Loughborough). Just before Loughborough turn left on to the A6004 Nottingham Road.

Drive through Loughborough, then left on to the A60 (signposted Nottingham)

Continue on the A60 – through the village of Cotes. Just before reaching Hoton turn right on to Prestwold Lane. The venue is on the left and will be signposted. Do not go in where the sign reads 'Prestwold Hall Driving Centre' – it is the second entrance, just before the bend. There will be a venue sign.

Facilities at venue:

Toilets / Water / Catering van

Please take litter home with you and do not muck trailers / boxes out at venue.

Dogs only permitted if they are on a lead at ALL TIMES at the direct request of the estate.

Checking in:

When you arrive please come up to the secretary and check in / collect your numbered bib.

Please check the notice board for any route changes, hazards or issues you need to be aware of on the day. Ride maps will also be displayed here and any queries or clarifications can be discussed.

Route:

See ride maps attached. The route will be marked with coloured arrows corresponding to the colours of routes marked on maps.

Distances:

Competitive 30 miles / 19 miles / 15 miles next step both days.

Pleasure 19 / 15 / 12 / 8 / 4 miles both days.

Conduct:

For non-members a Sport Endurance code of conduct and safety on rides sheet will be displayed at the venue. Please follow these rules and the Estate owner will be happy to have our events again in the future.
