



CLOCAENOG FOREST

Saturday & Sunday 23/24 July, 2016

VENUE: Waen Ganol Stables, Hiraethog, Ruthin, LL15 2DT.

DIRECTIONS: From Ruthin, take the B5105 signed Cerrigydrudion, keep going through the village of Clawdd Newydd then, after an S bend, take a right turn signed Cyffylliog. The turn is opposite a sign for Bod Petryal picnic area. Follow that road for one mile to the venue.

From the A5, the road via Merlin Y Wig is steep and narrow, so we suggest you continue on the A5 to Cerrigydrudion, then take the A5105 signed Ruthin. Go through Llanfihangel (over a bridge by a pub), then continue in the direction of Ruthin. When you enter the forestry area, look for a sign for Bod Petryal picnic area on your right. Dead opposite that you turn left for Cyffylliog, go up the lane for about a mile and the venue is on your right.

IMPORTANT: On all approaches, beware sat nav short cuts up small lanes. A B5105 is a good road for lorries/trailers.

Venue Arrival:

Riders can arrive at the venue from 11am.

Saturday: First horse out on course 12.30pm last horse away 2.30pm

Sunday: First horse out on course 9am last horse away 11.30am

Please ensure you print off a map and know your bib number. At the end of the ride members can record their official mileage on the list provided at the secretary.

Route

20/15 and 10 mile routes almost all within the forest on forestry tracks, small amount on very quiet lanes. Easy stream crossing.

3m (suitable for lead rein, young/novice horses – no stream crossing)

Facilities

Toilet, catering van, camping, corralling, stabling (please contact ride organiser for stables)

First Aider:

This event does not have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the secretary.

Notes:

There is no need to clear away droppings, our hosts have kindly said they will deal with them. But please do not leave any litter.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse’s tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion
