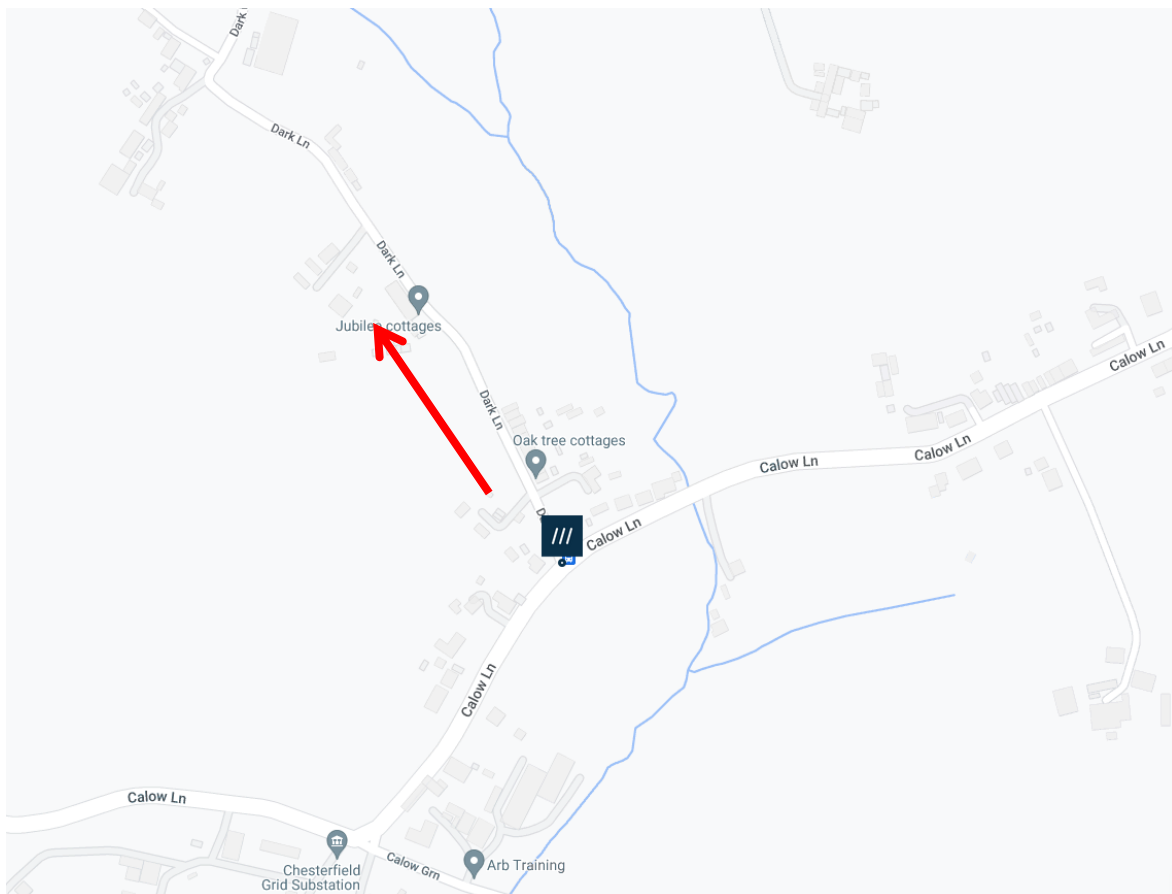
VENUE: Stanley Cottage Stables, Dark Lane, Calow, Chesterfield, S44 5UU

Venue: The venue is grass parking with some limited hardstanding for smaller vehicles. As conditions may be wet please follow parking marshals directions to park so that all vehicles are facing downhill for leaving. A tractor for towing is available should you get stuck.

Please clean up afterwards. Please note that there are NO Catering Van, water or toilets at the venue.

Directions: Dark Lane to the venue is single track with few passing places please access it from the SOUTH END ONLY off Calow Lane (/// roses.trying.fairly) to avoid problems with traffic and horses on the route to and from the venue



Venue Arrival:

Pleasure riders can arrive from 9.00am. First horse away 9.30am, Last horse 11.30. If you're riding the longer mileage please be on course by 11am and be back by 2.30pm.

Self-check in will be in operation at the secretary caravan. Don't forget to return your bib after the ride and (for members) record your mileage on the website when you get home..

Pleasure ride distances : 6 & 10 Miles . Please print a map off before you come.

THE VENUE IS A COMPULSORY WALK ZONE.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times

Route

Welcome to my home! I am very lucky to have a good network of multi user trails within hacking distance or a short trailer ride and i hope you enjoy my local routes . This ride includes the Chesterfield to Staveley part of the Trans Pennine Trail, linking other bridleways and Poolsbrook Country Park . Terrain is mostly off road surfaced paths with soft edges, woodland trail and some quiet roadwork. Please respect other trail users passing them at a walk

The route will be marked with spray painted arrows on the ground weather permitting, although we do ask all riders to bring a printed map with them. All Marshalls and helpers have given up there day to ensure you have a pleasurable ride, please thank them when passing through.

First Aider: This event does not have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the secretary.

Notes: Please clear droppings away and leave it tidy.

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be properly secured by a chin strap

Head Cameras may be used but are not recommended as may alter the safety of the hat.

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion
