Special arrangements due to extreme weather conditions

Everyone has worked extremely hard to ensure you and your horse have a safe enjoyable time. Ultimately it's the rider's responsibility to ensure you and your horse are properly prepared. Make sure you bring extra water to cool off your horse with.

Changes to Pleasure Start Times First horse away 9.30 last horse 11.30

- 1. Water buckets, Sloshes and cups of water for the riders will be available at all three checkpoints. (empty cups are to be left at checkpoints or taken with you back to venue)
- 2. Gazebos will be set up for your return back at the venue with again water buckets and sponges. (still bring your own supply)
- 3. Vet is in attendance until around 2/3pm

It's very important you ride at a pace suitable to your horse in these conditions.

Remember your sun cream and ensure you look after yourself as well as your horse.

FIRE HAZARDS

The estate is extremely dry, there is NO Smoking permitted on venue or any part of the ride as careless actions could wipe out hundreds of acres of woodland as well as livestock and game birds

If camping NO BBQ or Fires.
