## Venue:

Croxden Quarry, Cheadle, Stoke on Trent ST10 1RH.

THE POSTCODE PROVIDED WILL TAKE YOU TO THE PUB NEAR THE VENUE CALLED THE 'THE QUEENS AT FREEHAY'

# **Directions:**

Coming in from Tean, turn right onto Freehay road opposite the garage. Follow that road to the crossroads then straight over. Follow that road until you reach the roundabout then turn right into Coppice Lane. The venue entrance is on your left 200 yards after the roundabout.

Coming from Cheadle, take the B5032 for approximately 1 mile then turn right into Crownslow Road. Follow that road for approximately 1 mile then at the roundabout, straight over and the venue is 200 yards on your left.

Signs will be put up from the roundabout

## **VENUE ARRIVAL:**

Riders can arrive at the venue from 9.00am. First Horse away 9.30am, last horse 11.00am.

Self check in will be in operation at the secretary. Tick your name on the list, take two wristbands with emergency numbers – one for you and one to attach to your horse and take your numbered bib. Don't forget to return your bib after the ride and collect your rosette. Members can record mileage on the website when you get home.

Pleasure ride distances : 4, 9, 13, Miles. Please print a map off before you come.

# **ROUTE:**

You have a choice of official mileages: 4, 9 and 13 miles. Route is mainly forest tracks and a couple of small lanes, whatever the weather it's a great ride. No Stoney tracks so boots for horses are not essential.

There are some road crossings so please cross with care.

## **FACILITIES:**

NO TOILETS OR CATERING HOWEVER HOT DRINKS WILL BE SERVED AT £1 PER DRINK

**First Aider:** This event doesn't have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the secretary.

# **NOTES:**

Please leave venue in clean and tidy condition and clear dropping away. Please drive slowly down the drive as horses use this on the ride.

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be secured by chin strap and meet current standard

No Head Cameras (these are permitted on arm, leg or body)

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

#### TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

**RED RIBBON – My horse may kick** 

**GREEN RIBBON** – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON - My horse is a stallion
