



Swingate Ride

Sunday 25th August 2019

Venue: Swingate Farm Strelley Nottingham, NG16 2SU

Directions:

Important!!!!!! Please do not rely on sat navs to find venue as AA route finder and many sat navs still send you the old way through Strelley village and past Old Moor Farm where the road has been downgraded to a bridlepath!

From J26 M1 take the A610, take the Ikea turn off, then to Ikea roundabout where you take the 3rd exit signposted Kimberley, at mini roundabout in Kimberley (Sainsbury's) turn right, at the top of the road turn left, back over the A610 to a T junction, turn right (pub on right) it will say "no through road" but keep going, past some new houses on the right, tight bend to the left, and Swingate Farm is on the right with a long drive.

THE VENUE IS A COMPULSORY WALK ZONE.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times

Venue: You may arrive at the venue from 9.30am. Once you have parked up and unloaded your horses please come to the self-check-in at the secretary's tent, where you can collect your bib & emergency wrist bands. Don't forget to return your bib after the ride and collect your rosette. Members can record mileage on the website when you get home

First horse on course 9.45am last horse away 11.15am. If you intend to ride 18 miles then please leave as early as possible.

The route will be marked by painted arrows on the floor, tape in trees and arrows. All Marshalls and helpers have given up their day to ensure you have a pleasurable ride, please thank them when passing through.

Route options: 3, 7 & 9 mile (9m can be ridden twice for 18M)

Notes: There is 1 bridge over the M1 on both the 7 and 9 mile routes which are wide and have high sided railings; these also have concrete mounting blocks on both sides

On Site: There will be a Catering Van for you to purchase drinks, hot and cold food, water & toilet

Passports: Please don't forget your passports as they will be checked for flu vaccinations, horses will be allowed on site if they have either had a booster within the last 12 months or have had the first 2 vaccinations of a new programme. However, please check your passports for historical discrepancies as you may need to start a new course if your own vet thinks it

First Aider: This event does not have an official first aider but there are plenty helpers who are qualified in first aid, a first aid kit will be at the secretary tent.

Ride organiser will wear green tabard

All other officials will wear yellow tabards

**NB. ALL LATE BOOKINGS NOT ON THE BIB NUMBERS LIST
MUST BRING A PRINTED COPY OF THEIR BOOKING
CONFIRMATION TO GIVE TO THE SECRETARY**

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be secured by chin strap and meet current standard

Head Cameras may be used but are not recommended as may alter the safety of the hat.

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion

REMEMBER YOUR BIB NUMBER FOR THE SECRETARY

Please print off your map

All droppings must be picked up off the venue and taken home with you
