



Catton Park

Sunday 9th July 2017

NEW Venue: Catton Hall, Catton Park, Derbyshire, DE12 8LN. (near Walton-on-Trent)

Venue: The venue is approximately 150 yards up from the usual venue on the right.

Field parking with water and toilets. Catering will be available from 11.30am

<u>DIRECTIONS</u> Grid reference SK207154. (Postcode DE12 8LN).

Catton Park is situated midway between Lichfield and Burton upon Trent with easy access from all main motorways. Leave the A38 at Alrewas and take the A513 towards Tamworth: travel for 1.5 miles and immediately under the Railway Bridge turn left, Catton Hall is situated on that road 1 mile along on the left hand side, the venue field is on the right about half a mile past the hall. (Do not approach Catton via Walton upon Trent as there is a weight and width restriction on the Trent Bridge).

Look out for the Sport Endurance signs!

THE VENUE IS A COMPULSORY WALK ZONE. DOGS MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES

Pleasure Riders. You can arrive at the venue from 9.30am, Pleasure ride times are first horse away 10am Last horse 12.30pm

Once you have parked up and unloaded your horses please make your way to the self check-in at the secretaries' tent, where you will collect your rider bib and wrist bands.

Route: 10 miles can be ridden twice. Lead rein route also available.

The route has been especially mown for your enjoyment, please only ride on the mown track to avoid any hidden hazards

The route will be mark by painted arrows on the floor, tape in trees and arrows.

There may be one field to ride through with sheep present so please ride carefully. There will be two road crossings and approximately 60 yards of country lane to ride down.

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be properly secured by a chin strap

No Head Cameras (these are permitted on arm, leg or body)

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Camping: Those staying over Saturday evening can arrive at the venue from 3pm – you need to contact Sam prior to your arrival. Sam 07869 714141

Weather: The weather forecast is warm and sunny, please consider this whilst out on course and ride according to the conditions. There will be a water out on course plus taps in case they need refilling you may need to dismount. Don't forget your sun cream.

First Aider

This event does not have an official first aider, a first aid kit will be at the secretary tent.

NB. ALL LATE BOOKINGS NOT ON THE BIB NUMBERS LIST MUST BRING A PRINTED COPY OF THEIR BOOKING CONFIRMATION TO GIVE TO THE SECRETARY

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON - My horse is a stallion
