VENUE ARRIVAL:

Riders can arrive at the venue from 9.00am. Last Horse away 11.00am. (All 19 milers away by 10.00 please)

Self check in will be in operation at the secretary. Tick your name on the list, take two wristbands with emergency numbers – one for you and one to attach to your horse and take your numbered bib. Don't forget to return your bib after the ride and collect your rosette. Members can record mileage on the website when you get home.

Pleasure ride distances: 8, 14, 19, Miles. Please print a map off before you come.

ROUTE:

You have a choice of official mileages: 8, 14 and 19 miles. Route is predominantly a traffic free multi-user route along a disused railway line with flat terrain.

For over a 100 years trains travelled along this route carrying coal from Staffordshire to Congleton. Those of you doing the longest route will go to the restored Whitfield Colliery site where you will see Britain's biggest remaining colliery site, which has been designated by English Heritage as an Ancient Scheduled Monument.

The route will be marked between the venue and the start of the Biddulph Valley Way, at the 8 & 14 mile turn around points and around Whitfield Colliery. For the remainder of the route along the Biddulph Valley Way simply follow the sign-posts for route 55.

Please note that horses are requested to walk and trot only on the main track. There is an additional track for cantering provided along a section of the route & cantering opportunities along bridleways around Whitfield Colliery.

There are some road crossings so please cross with care.

FACILITIES:

No Catering, no toilet, no water

First Aider: This event doesn't have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the secretary.

NOTES:

Please leave venue in clean and tidy condition and clear dropping away.

PHOTOGRAPHER:

Sorry no photographer.

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30” as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be secured by chin strap and meet current standard

Head Cameras may be used but are not recommended as may alter the safety of the hat (they are safer on arm, leg or body)

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse’s tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion
