Venue: Prestwold Hall, Prestwold Lane, Prestwold, nr **Loughborough**, Leics **LE12 5SQ**

Venue: The venue is by kind permission of Edward Packe-Drury-Lowe, Prestwold Hall Estate with field parking. There are toilets, water and a Catering van.

Competitors can arrive at the venue from 7.00am, Pleasure riders can arrive from 9am. Once you have parked up and unloaded your horses please make your way to the self check-in at the secretaries' tent, where you will be collect your rider bib and wrist bands.

Competitors Briefing – This will take place at the secretary's tent.

Competitors – Your vet times have been allocated on a separate document. Please note you risk elimination if you are late for the vetting. Please make sure you notify the vet writer upon arrival at the vetting. The time you have been given is your time. You **WILL NOT** be able to vet earlier than your time so please do not push in or hang around the vetting area.

The vetting will take approximately 3 minutes as your heart rate will be taken for a full minute. The vet on duty is Caroline.

Check the board upon arrival for last minute route changes and confirmed distances as times & points will be worked out from the official mileages displayed on the day. Please ensure you have read the rules

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be properly secured by a chin strap

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Pleasure Riders. You can arrive at the venue from 9am, Pleasure ride times are first horse away 10.30am Last horse 1.00pm.

Lead Rein 1pm.

Please be aware that no pleasure riders will be allowed out on course until 10.30am this is to allow the competitors to get underway.

Pleasure Miles: 4,8,12,15 & 19

The route will be marked by painted arrows on the floor, tape in trees and arrows. All Marshalls and helpers have given up there day to ensure you have a pleasurable ride, please thank them when passing through.

Information on the area of the ride:

The venue and route is by kind permission of Edward Packe-Drury-Lowe, Prestwold Hall Estate. The route is across the private estate, on the permissive bridle routes surrounding Prestwold, Hoton and Cotes. Terrain is mostly gently rolling to flat, wide grassy field edges with very little road work. Any gates should be open.

Directions:

From the North and South – M1 to Junction 24 – then take the A6 Derby Road (signposted Kegworth / Loughborough). Just before Loughborough turn left on to the A6004 Nottingham Road. Drive through Loughborough, then left on to the A60 (signposted Nottingham) Continue on the A60 – through the village of Cotes. Just before reaching Hoton turn right on to Prestwold Lane. The venue is on the left and will be signposted. Do not go in where the sign reads Prestwold Hall Driving Centre’ – it is the second entrance, just before the bend. There will be a venue sign.

First Aider

This event does not have an official first aider but there are plenty helpers who are qualified in first aid, a first aid kit will be at the secretary tent.

Vet in Attendance – Caroline (she will be wearing a red tabard saying VET)

Ride organiser & Technical stewards will wear green tabards

All other officials will wear yellow tabards

Red Bibs = Competitor Rider



Orange Bibs = Next Step Class



Yellow Bibs = Pleasure Rider

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion

REMEMBER YOUR BIB NUMBER FOR THE SECETARY

Please print off your map, Vet sheets if required

Please take litter home with you and do not muck trailers / boxes out at venue
