

Wharncliffe Ride

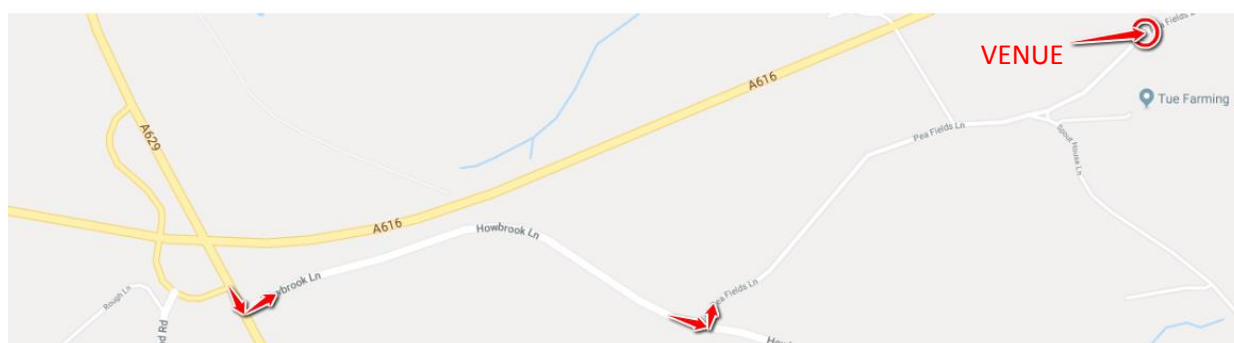
Sunday 5th August 2018

VENUE: Bromley Farm, Wortley, Sheffield, S35 7DE

VENUE: The venue is hard-standing. There are toilets, water, and a café.

DIRECTIONS:

Situated just off the A616, Sheffield to Manchester road. Come off the A616 at the junction signposted for Huddersfield, Penistone, Wortley (A629). Turn right onto the A629 and first left onto Howbrook Lane. Follow the brown signs for Bromley Farm.



Venue Arrival:

Riders can arrive at the venue from 9.30am. First Horse out on course 9.45am, last Horse away 11.45am.

Please ensure you print off a map and know your bib number. Once you have parked up please make your way to the self-check in at the secretaries' tent where you will be collect your rider bib and wrist bands. Don't forget to return your bib after the ride and collect your rosette. Members can record mileage on the website when you get home

Facilities

The venue has toilets, water and a café, which will be serving drinks and food on the day.

Camping

Those staying over Saturday evening can arrive at the venue from 5pm – before dark. **The venue has requested that no one camping and corraling arrive before 5pm.**

Route

The route will be marked with spray painted arrows on the ground, although we do ask all riders to bring a printed map with them. The **6 Mile** route is around gently rolling parkland with just a few hundred yards of roadwork to start with. The **12 & 16 Mile** routes have some roadwork along relatively quiet country lanes. These routes also go through a few farmers' fields, which have unmanned horse-friendly gates and **LIVESTOCK PRESENT**. A few paths are narrow, so please be aware of walkers and dogs. The **16 Mile** route has a **shallow ford crossing**, which cannot be avoided.

Please keep to the edges of headlands and marked paths – do not ride through any of the crops.

First Aider: This event does not have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the secretary.

Notes: Please clear droppings away and take home. Do not leave on venue.

**NB. ALL LATE BOOKINGS NOT ON THE BIB NUMBERS LIST
MUST BRING A PRINTED COPY OF THEIR BOOKING
CONFIRMATION TO GIVE TO THE SECRETARY**

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be properly secured by a chin strap

No Head Cameras (these are permitted on arm, leg or body)

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion
