



ILAM RIDE

Sunday 15th September 2019

VENUE: Latham Hall Farm, Green Lane, off Calton Moor, near Swinscoe DE6 2BU

DIRECTIONS: DO NOT FOLLOW SAT NAV DIRECTIONS FOR THE LAST 300 YARDS - FOLLOW DIRECTIONS BELOW - THERE WILL BE SIGNPOSTS TO THE VENUE

From Stoke – Take the A52 towards Ashbourne. You will go through Froghall , Whiston and the edge of Cauldon Lowe. At the main road junction with the A523 turn left towards Leek and then **immediately right** into Green Lane – signposted Calton. **Do not go straight across at the main road junction to head to Ilam.** The venue field is the second field on the left off Green Lane.

From Leek – Take the A523 towards Ashbourne. Go through Waterhouses village and climb up a hill. You will go over some rumble strips and the road then levels off. **Just before** the A52 turn to Stoke take the left turn to Calton into Green Lane. The venue field is the second field on the left off Green Lane. **Please give motorists plenty of warning that you are turning left as this junction is in a dip in the main road.**

From Ashbourne – Take the A52 from Ashbourne towards Leek. You will climb a steep hill and pass through Swinscoe village. About 1 mile from Swinscoe there is a junction with a left turn to Stoke. **Immediately after** this junction turn right at the signpost to Calton into Green Lane. **Do not** turn right at the main road junction to Ilam.

There will be warning signs close to the A523/A52 junction to advise other traffic using the road that there will be trailers and horse boxes turning just before or after this junction – look out for these.

VENUE ARRIVAL: Riders can arrive at the venue from 8.45 am. First Horse out on course 9.30 am. All 16 and 20 mile riders to be out on course 10.00 am. Last Horse away 11.00 am

The venue is field parking. No hard standing available. All vehicles will be shown where to park by a steward.

Self check in will be in operation at the secretary. Tick your name on the list, take two wristbands with emergency numbers – one for you and one to attach to your horse and take your numbered bib. Don't forget to return your bib after the ride and collect your rosette. Members can record mileage on the website when you get home.

THE VENUE FIELD IS A WALK ONLY ZONE. DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE VENUE FIELD BUT MUST BE KEPT ON A LEAD AT ALL TIMES.

Please note that Latham Hall Farm is a holiday cottage and is occupied on Saturday and Sunday. The owners have asked that noise is kept to a minimum and that no-one should walk near the house or the land on the main road side of the drive to respect the holiday makers enjoyment and privacy.

Please clear droppings from the field and take any rubbish home with you.

ROUTE: There are four route options – 6, 10, 16 and 20 miles.

There are 2 maps for this ride – Loop 1 (6 miles)and the additional Loop 2 (4 miles) to give a total of 10 miles. Please ensure you print off **BOTH** maps if you plan to do any distance exceeding 6 miles and also that you know your bib number.

The ride will be mainly over fields, with some quiet lanes and tracks. There are some steep ascents and descents – riders may wish to dismount on some of the descents. There is an alternative route down the road to miss the steepest hill on Loop 1 but riders will have to open and close the 2 gates on the road route themselves. There are many canter opportunities and stunning views. There are many gates on route but it is planned that all will be manned. There will be cattle and sheep on the route.

There will be horses travelling two ways on parts of the route – these areas are shown by two way arrows on the plans – please pass carefully and be courteous on these sections.

The ride will be marked with tape, paint and with black arrows on a yellow background.

FACILITIES: Toilets and catering on site. Catering is being provided by volunteers to raise funds for Ilam Primary School. Bacon and vegetarian butties, hot and cold drinks and home made cakes! There is no water at the venue but there are some cattle troughs along the ride routes.

RAFFLE: A raffle will take place to raise funds for Ilam Primary School. Raffle tickets will be on sale from 9.00 am to 12.00 noon - please buy tickets when you book in. The raffle will be drawn just after noon so please check if you have won when you hand your bib back in.

FIRST AIDER: This event does not have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the Secretary's trailer.

NOTES: Camping and Corralling – you can arrive at the venue from **4.00 pm onwards** on Saturday 15 September. Follow the signs in the venue field to the camping/corralling area.

Please keep noise to minimum as Latham Hall Farm is occupied by holiday makers.

FOR YOUR OWN SAFETY – CHECK THE NOTICE BOARD ON THE DAY OF THE RIDE TO CHECK IF THERE ARE ANY LATE ROUTE CHANGES AND READ THE RISK ASSESSMENT

Passports: Please don't forget your passports as they will be checked for flu vaccinations, horses will be allowed on site if they have either had a booster within the last 12 months or have had the first 2 vaccinations of a new programme. However, please check your passports for historical discrepancies as you may need to start a new course if your own vet thinks it

RULES:

ALL RIDERS SHOULD READ THROUGH OUR RULES – THESE CAN BE FOUND ON OUR WEBSITE

No SPURS or whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be secured by chin strap and meet current standard

Head Cameras may be used but are not recommended as may alter the safety of the hat.

NEVER PASS ANOTHER HORSE WITHOUT ASKING PERMISSION FIRST, ALWAYS PASS AT A PACE NO MORE THAN TROT. REMEMBER THAT NOT EVERYONE MAY BE A CONFIDENT RIDER OR THEY MAY HAVE A NOVICE HORSE, PLEASE WEAR THE FOLLOWING TAIL RIBBONS FOR GUIDANCE.

TAIL RIBBONS:

Please wear the following ribbons in your horse's tail if needed:

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion

NB. ALL LATE BOOKINGS NOT ON THE BIB NUMBERS LIST MUST BRING A PRINTED COPY OF THEIR BOOKING CONFIRMATION TO GIVE TO THE SECRETARY
