Venue Arrival:

Venue is a grass field (No hard standing). Note that there are NO are toilets or water on the field but toilets are nearby. Catering van will be available

Riders can arrive at the venue from 9.00am. Once you have parked up and unloaded your horses please come to the self check-in at the secretary's tent, where you can collect your bib & emergency wrist bands.

Check the board upon arrival for last minute route changes and confirmed distances as times & points will be worked out from the official mileages displayed on the day.

THE VENUE IS A COMPULSORY WALK ZONE.

Dogs must be kept on leads at all times

Pleasure Riders.

Pleasure ride times are first horse away 9.30am, all 13 milers must be away for 10.30, last horse away at 11am.

All riders to be back at the venue for 2pm please. Don't forget to return your bib after the ride and members may write down your mileage on the check in sheet.

Pleasure Miles: 5 & 13

The route will be marked by painted arrows on the floor, tape in trees and arrows. All Marshalls and helpers have given up there day to ensure you have a pleasurable ride, please thank them when passing through

Ride Details:

Situated in the south Leicestershire not far from Lutterworth and the M1 junction 20 and the A5 there will plenty of canter opportunities and mainly all off road using bridle ways and quiet lanes.

For the non-riders attending the hall will be open to visit - Ride venue is in the monument field

First Aider:

This event does not have an official first aider, however there is a first aid kit located at the secretary.

Facilities: Catering will be available. THERE IS NO WATER OR TOILETS ON SITE, however Toilets are nearby

Equine Flu Vaccinations: Riders are required to carry their horse passports at all times and horses must have up to date vaccination against equine influenza. The Sport Endurance minimum requirement is either an annual booster within the last 12 months or the first two vaccinations of a new programme.

By agreeing to our Terms and Conditions when booking a ride, you are confirming that your horse will have the required vaccination against equine influenza on the day of the ride. You may be refused entry to the venue if this is not the case

Notes: All droppings and rubbish must be picked up off the venue and taken home

**NB. ALL LATE BOOKINGS NOT ON THE BIB NUMBERS LIST
MUST BRING A PRINTED COPY OF THEIR BOOKING CONFIRMATION (OR
SHOW CONFIRMATION EMAIL ON THEIR PHONE)**

No SPURS or Whips longer than 30" as per our rules.

Standing Martingale are also not permitted without written approval prior to the ride

Hats must be properly secured by a chin strap

Head Cameras may be used but are not recommended as may alter the safety of the hat.

All riders should take time to read through our rules – these can be found on our website.

Never pass another horse without asking permission first, always pass at a pace no more than trot. Remember that not everyone may be a confident rider or they may have a novice horse, please see below tail ribbons for guidance.

TAIL RIBBONS

Please wear the follow ribbons in your horse's tail if needed.

RED RIBBON – My horse may kick

GREEN RIBBON – I or my horse are nervous /novice, approach with caution and pass with care

BLUE RIBBON – My horse is a stallion
